THE PROCESSOR'S COOKIES FILES POLICY

1. INTRODUCTION

This Policy explains what cookies are, what types of cookies we use, what information we collect, and how Joint Stock Company Izhevsky Opytno-Mekhanichesky Zavod (INN 1832028112) (Processor) uses this information. This Cookies Policy is an integral part of the Processor's Privacy Policy.

2. WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE COOKIES POLICY AND THE PRIVACY POLICY OF THE PROCESSOR?

The Cookies Policy applies the use of cookies files on the website, whereas the Privacy Policy is a general document covering all data processing processes, including feedback forms, distribution lists, etc.

3. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies files are small pieces of information that are stored by the browser on the computer's hard drive. Each time you visit our website again, your web browser sends us these pieces of information so that we can customize the interface to your interests and preferences, or to facilitate the process of logging in to use our services.

4. WE USE COOKIES FOR:

The Processor uses cookies to improve the quality of the website, simplify the operation with the website and improve user service. Cookies files allow the Processor to monitor and analyze the use of the website. When using the Processor's website(s), the User consents to the use of cookies in accordance with this cookie type policy. If the User does not agree with the use of this type of files, the latter, in turn, shall adjust its browser settings accordingly or not use the Processor's website(s).

5. WHERE DO WE HOST COOKIES?

You may receive cookies when using our website.

6. TYPES OF COOKIES

The cookies that are used on the website are discussed below, in accordance with the recommendations of the International Chamber of Commerce by the categories of cookies files.

- Strictly mandatory cookies. These cookies are necessary for the operation of the website and allow you to use its important functions. Strictly mandatory cookies are necessary for important website functions. Without them, the proper operation of the website is impossible and the user cannot navigate the website and use its functions. Strictly mandatory cookies can also identify the user as having logged in to the website and provide a connection to secure areas of the website. If the user has prohibited the acceptance of these cookies, he/she will not be able to use the website or some parts of the website will not work properly.
- Performance cookies. These cookies collect information about the use of the website(s), for example, about the most frequently visited pages. Such data can be used to optimize our websites and simplify navigation. These cookies are also used by our affiliates to determine whether you have accessed our website from an affiliated website, whether you have used our services and whether you have purchased our products as a result of visiting the website, including which products and services you have purchased. These files are not used to collect personal data. All information collected using such cookies is intended for statistical purposes and remains anonymous.
- Functional cookies. These cookies allow our website(s) to remember the choices you made when browsing the website. For example, this file may remember your location, which will allow us to display our website in the language of your country. These files can also be used to

memorise settings such as text size and font, as well as other customizable website settings. The information provided by such files does not allow you to be identified.

7. INFORMATION THAT WE COLLECT

When you use cookies files hosted on our website, the following data is collected:

- 1) About the User's computer;
- 2) About the device and browser (for example, IP-address, operating system and device specifications, language preferences, visited URL-addresses links, date and time of access to the website(s), and other information about the software or hardware.

If you access the Processor's website from a mobile or other device, information about that device is collected, including the UDID (Unique Device Identifier).

8. COOKIES HOSTED BY THIRD PARTIES

When you visit our website(s), you may receive cookies from third-party websites and third parties hosted on our website(s) (for example, Facebook, Twitter, Youtube service files). We, in turn, make every effort to identify and outline these files. Nevertheless, the Processor assumes no liability for the actions of these third parties, and you should additionally read more detailed information about these cookies installed by third parties (a list of cookies can be found in your browser) on the relevant websites of these third parties.

9. CONTROL AND DELETION OF COOKIES

If you would like to limit or block the use of cookies, you can do this in your browser settings. If you use different devices to view and access our websites (for example, a computer, smart phone, tablet, etc.), then you shall make sure that each browser on each device is configured according to your point of view on working with cookies. You can change the settings so that to block cookies or that you receive a notification when files of this type are sent to your device. To perform these actions, refer to the browser instructions.

Note: If you disable the cookies we use, you will not be able to see some parts of the web resources or receive personal information when visiting the website.
